## **Document Cases with Handles and Windows or String Pulls**

Conservation Resources document cases are available in an .060 acid- free grey/ white board, an acid-, lignin-, and sulfur- free .060 Lig-Free Type I board, and the patented .065 MicroChamber board, which affords all of the benefits of our Lig-Free Type I board while actively contributing to the preservation of the material it holds.

The 5 in. boxes are available with a choice of a pull string or a metal handle to assist in removing them from the shelves. Boxes with metal handles also feature a slot, or window, into which an identification card may be slipped with details regarding the collection within. The metal handle is considered more durable than the nylon strings. Boxes with string pulls are available with or without an integral support bar. The integral support bar system offers notches in the inner flaps of the box which allows the support bar to be placed where needed to hold documents and folders upright, without curling, in boxes which are not completely filled.

### **Traditional File Folders**

Conservation Resources' file folders meet extremely stringent specifications for both paper strength and paper chemistry. Our standard file folders are made from our Lig-Free I .010 paper, which goes over 1000 double folds in the weakest direction, has 3% alkaline buffering, a pH of 8.5, and is lignin-free. They are available with reinforced or non-reinforced tabs. Our lignin-free photographic file folders are made from white, .010, neutral, non-buffered paper. They exhibit the same remarkable folding endurance as our .010 Lig-Free I folders. All of Conservation Resources' file folders have full tabs.

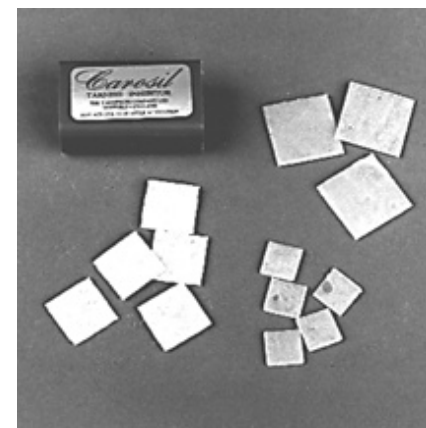

### **Carosil Plastabs**

Ultra-thin and highly effective against airborne pollutants, Plastabs are available in three sizes, 1/2 in. square, 3/4 in. square, and 1 in. square. They are highly effective inhibitors for silverware, ferrous and non-ferrous metals, and glass. The proprietary V.C.I. formulation emits an odourless, non-toxic vapour which is diffused throughout the enclosed space until the air is saturated. The vapour then provides passivity to the surface of the artefact, protecting against tarnish and corrosion by reducing the electro-chemical activity on these surfaces. The lifespan is up to 12 months. The 1/2 in. Plastabs protect up to 150 cubic inches, 3/4 in. protect up to 300 cubic inches, and 1 in. Plastabs cover up to 500 cubic inches. Plastabs are available in packages of 20 of a given size.

### ***Leather-Covered Lead Weights***

Covered in soft black leather, these weights are handy in a variety of situations. Filled with lead shot, and available in three weights and two shapes, they may be used to stabilize ceramics, hold down awkward items such as scrolls on display, or keep boards in place when making phase boxes.

### ***Shoe String Weights***

These white cords contain small (approximately 1/4 in. long) lead weights spaced extremely close together. They are 3 mm in diameter and weigh about 3.25 ounces per yard. Uses for them include holding books open while on display, keeping items flat while performing treatments, or in endeavours to flatten items which have been previously stored rolled. Weights are sold by the yard; multiple yards will be shipped as one length.

## ***Quake Hold Products***

There are three types of Quake Hold products, each with certain characteristics which make it the better choice for one application or another.

**MUSEUM GEL-** This is the best choice for anchoring glass or crystal objects as it is invisible on clear objects and glass shelves. Roll it into little ball, set the artifact in place, and the gel sets in hour or so. It is reusable and non-toxic. Museum gel is also the best choice for items which are frequently moved. The gel is not susceptible to aging, though replacing it every time you clean the objects (or 3-4 times a year) is suggested. It is available in 4-oz. containers.

**MUSEUM PUTTY-** This is the most universal product with the widest range of applications; it is strongly recommended for frequently moved objects. It is best for figurines, ceramics, porcelain, and adheres to most surfaces. It is clean to the touch and adheres instantly. Putty is suggested as the best choice for objects with pedestal feet. Non toxic, the putty is easy to apply and to remove, and is the choice in hot environments. Recommended for items which are often removed and replaced, it can be reused. Use putty on walls behind pictures, though it may leave some residue. It has proven to be the most popular product among retail consumers. It is available in 2.64 oz. containers.

**MUSEUM WAX-** This is a specially-blended combination of microcrystalline waxes designed for use with antiquities in museums. It is the best choice for objects on wood (like shelves); it is also good for the wood-after a year or so it becomes more difficult to remove but is still removable. Museum wax adheres instantly, and is the least susceptible to aging or drying once in place if left on an object for 6 (or more) months, making it the best choice for more permanent displays. Recommended for long term museum displays when clarity isn't an issue (as it is with glass objects or glass shelves), though replacing it every time you clean the objects (3-4 times /year) is suggested. Available in 50 gram tubs.
